



PRESCHOOL THE BEGINNING

Young Reader's Bible: The Beginning

Supplies: Creation papers, scissors

Point to Drive Home: God created everything.

Open: Greet each child by name and play for five minutes

Song: Sing a song from the boom box. If the kids are interested, create motions and invite them to dance and sing along.

Story Time:

Take the bigger kids into the story room (leaving the door open and using the gate). Have them choose a carpet square to sit on for the story.

Ask: Do you have a favorite animal? What about a favorite plant? Allow the kids to share their answers. Tell them, "God created everything! Today, we're going to learn about when God created the whole world. Does anyone know how many days he took to create the world? (Only six! And he rested on the seventh).

Read them the story of Creation from the Young Reader's Bible.

Craft:

Allow the kids to color the picture that represents each day of creation from the printed pages below. Then you can help them cut the out and put them on the right day, reminding them of what God did on each day.

Allow Free Play for the rest of the time.

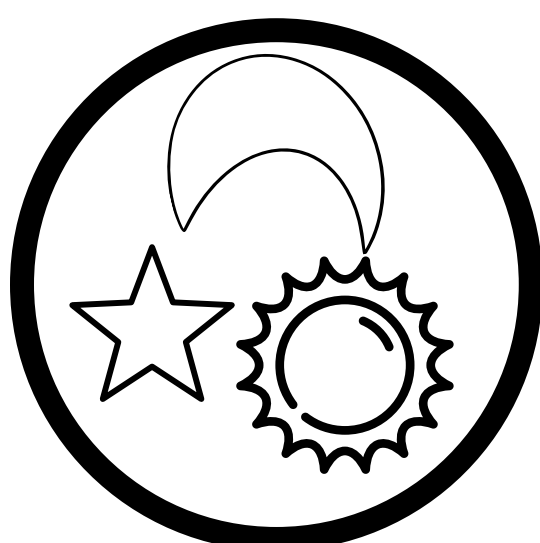
