



## PRESCHOOL WATER, WATER EVERYWHERE

**Young Reader's Bible:** Water, Water Everywhere

**Supplies:** Paper plates, cotton balls, glue, markers/crayons

**Main Point to Drive Home:** God keeps his promises

**Open:** Greet each child by name and play for three-five minutes

**Song:** (Optional) Sing a song from the boom box. If the kids are interested, create motions and invite them to dance and sing along.

### **Story Time:**

Take the bigger kids into the story room (leaving the door open and using the gate). Have them choose a carpet square to sit on for the story.

**Ask:** Who can remember what the mean, sneaky snake did in our story last week? (Tempted Eve and Adam to eat from the tree God said they couldn't eat from). What happened after they ate from it? (They were kicked out of the garden, God made them clothes)

**Read** the story "Water, Water Everywhere" from the Young Reader's Bible.

### **Craft:**

Say: People were disobeying God. Remember that means that they weren't doing what he said. So he sent a whole flood to cover the earth, but God save Noah, his family, and lots of animals. Then what did he put in the sky to promise he wouldn't flood the whole earth again? (A rainbow). Today, we're going to make a rainbow craft to remind us that God keeps his promises. Using half a paper plate, guide the kids in coloring in the lines to make a rainbow (Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple). Glue cotton balls on the base for clouds.

Allow Free Play for the rest of the time.

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
