Young Reader's Bible: Sold! A Sneaky Deal

Supplies: Coat print outs for the kids to color. Optional: Tissue paper.

Main Point to Drive Home: Joseph's brothers were jealous and wrongfully treated him.

Open: Greet each child by name and play for three-five minutes

Song: (Optional) Sing a song from the boom box. If the kids are interested, create motions and invite them to dance and sing along.

Story Time:

Take the bigger kids into the story room (leaving the door open and using the gate). Have them choose a carpet square to sit on for the story.

Explain: Last week, we talked about when Jacob dreamt of angels and built an altar to God. This week, we're going to learn about Jacob's sons. Did you know he had 12 sons? In the Bible, Jacob gets the new name of Israel and his 12 sons eventually form the 12 tribes of Israel. Let's learn about a story involving the sons.

Read "Sold! A Sneaky Deal."

Explain: Joseph's brothers were jealous of him and treated him poorly. Does anyone know what jealousy means? It means that a person feels upset or angry because of what another person has. The brothers did the wrong thing because of jealousy. Next week, we'll learn how God was with Joseph through everything.

Craft:

Have the kids color the coats to remember Joseph's coat of many colors. Or, use colorful squares of tissue paper to decorate the coat.
