Young Reader's Bible: Ten Terrible Troubles

Supplies: Coloring supplies, brads, print out

Main Point to Drive Home: God saved the Israelites from slavery in Egypt by showing his power.

Open: Greet each child by name and play for three-five minutes

Song: (Optional) Sing a song from the boom box. If the kids are interested, create motions and invite them to dance and sing along.

Story Time:

Take the bigger kids into the story room (leaving the door open and using the gate). Have them choose a carpet square to sit on for the story.

Explain: Last week, we learned about how God called Moses to a special job. Today, we're going to see how God showed his amazing power over the Egyptians through Moses with 10 plagues.

Read "Ten Terrible Troubles"

Explain: God used amazing signs to show the Egyptians that he is the only true God. After all those signs, the Pharoah let the Israelites go.

Craft:

Make a circle craft that shows each of the ten plagues that Egypt faced. **Instructions:**

Color each plague (the blank wedge is for darkness and should be colored black). Then place the cover over top and insert a brad into the middle so the kids can see each plague.
