Young Reader's Bible: ½ of A Special Treasure

Supplies: Hand printouts

Main Point to Drive Home: God gave his people 10 commandments to follow.

Open: Greet each child by name and play for three-five minutes

Song: (Optional) Sing a song from the boom box. If the kids are interested, create motions and invite them to dance and sing along.

Story Time:

Take the bigger kids into the story room (leaving the door open and using the gate). Have them choose a carpet square to sit on for the story.

Explain: Last week, we talked about how God provided quail, manna, and water for the Israelites. This week, we're going to talk about the laws he gave his special treasure.

Read "A Special Treasure" after the line "because God was there."

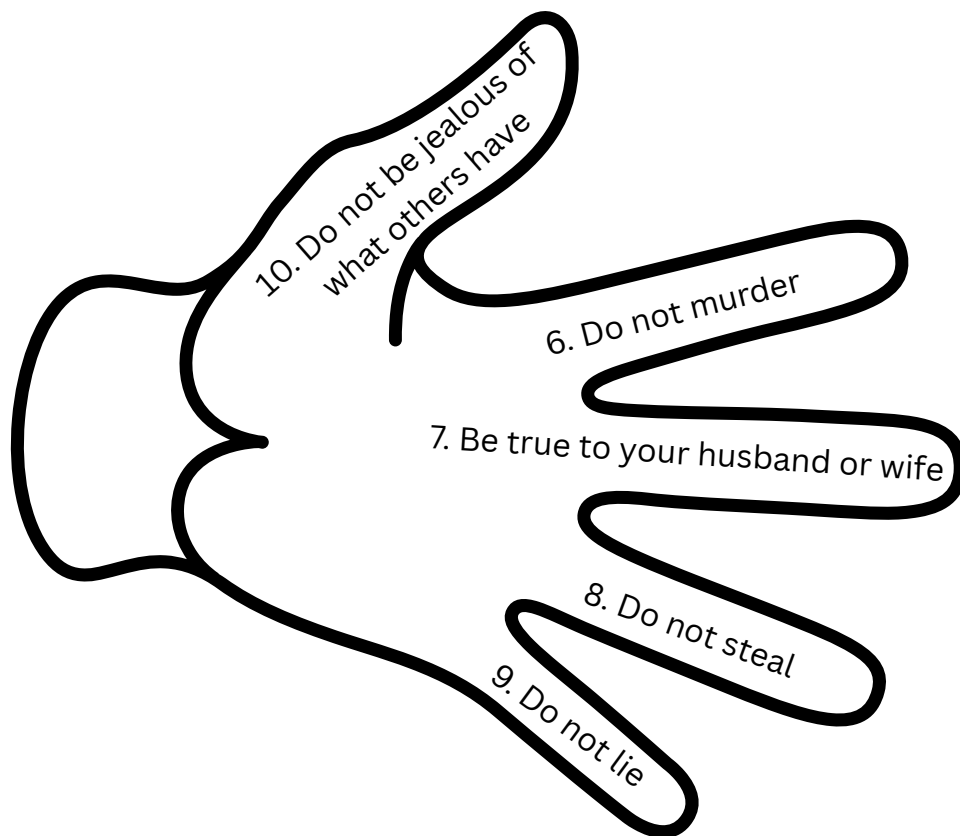
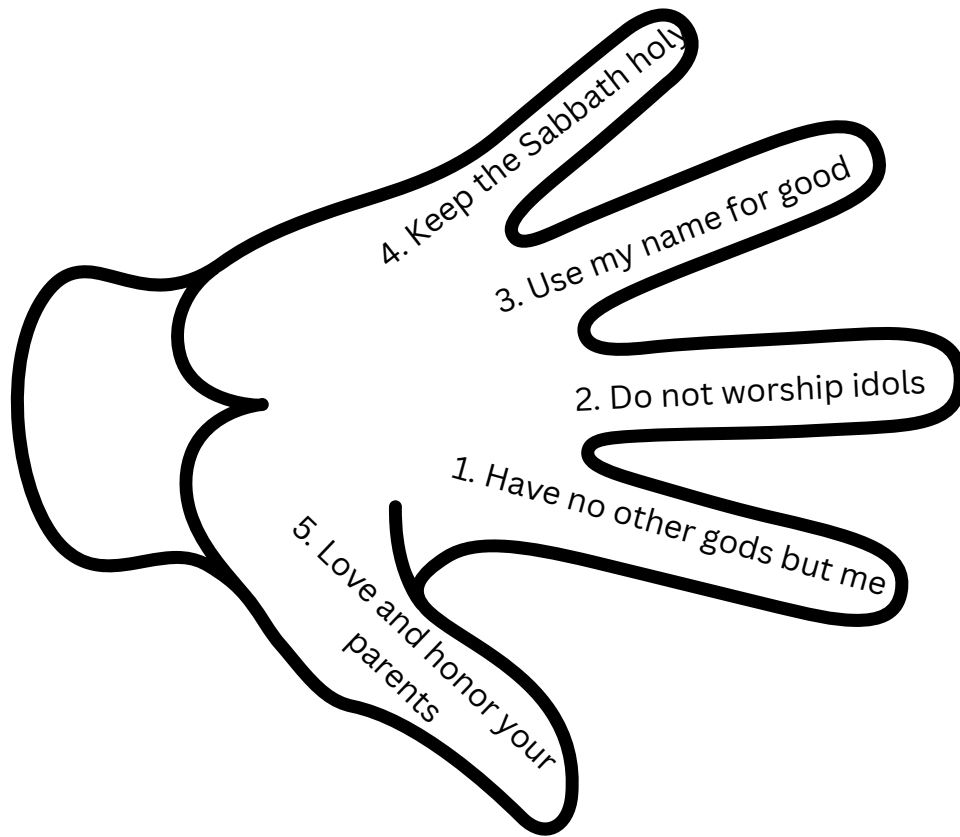
Explain: God knows what is best for us and he knows that what is best is when we obey his laws. Let's learn these ten commandments.

Craft:

Color the hands with the finger commandments.

Activity:

If you would like and your kids are capable, you could teach them the ten finger commandments listed at the end of the lesson.



Finger 10 Commandments



1. He is the One True God, no others before him.



2. Cut out all the idols.



3. Don't misuse his name.



4. Keep the Sabbath Holy. Go to church, then rest. (Walk your finger along your arm, then flip them over).



5. Honor your father and mother (place your hand across your heart, then salute).



6. Don't murder (Hold out a hand for "Don't" then slice your finger across your neck).



7. Don't commit adultery. (Bind 2 together, then hide the others behind your back and say, don't go looking at anyone else).



8. Don't steal. (Slide three fingers toward a pocket, have the other hand grab them).



9. No false testimony. Don't say five is four and four is five (holding out each hand as you say it's number).



10. Don't covet. Don't be wanting other people's stuff. (Hold out your hands like you're trying to grab their things, while shaking your head).
