

PRESCHOOL SOLOMON'S ONE WISH

Young Reader's Bible: Solomon's One Wish

Supplies: Q-tips, marshmallows, and paper plates.

Open: Greet each child by name and play for three-five minutes, go over the classroom rules.

Main Point to Drive Home: King David sang praises to God.

Story Time:

Take the bigger kids into the story room (leaving the door open and using the gate). Have them choose a carpet square to sit on for the story.

Review: Review the 10 Commandments up to what the kids know, add another if they're ready. Ask what they remember from the story last week. (They learned about David's Psalms). Explain: After David Solomon became king of Israel. Today, we'll learn about him.

Read "Solomon's One Wish"

Explain: Solomon knew he needed God to help him rule well, so he asked for wisdom. Does anyone know what wisdom is? (Good judgement and knowledge from experience). We aren't wise on our own, but our God is all-knowing and wise. And he gives us wisdom when we ask. Solomon also built a temple for the Lord. Today, we're going to build temples out of marshmallows and toothpicks.

Do a Craft:

Build with toothpicks and marshmallows, talking about how beautiful the temple of God was.
