



PRESCHOOL THE LORD, HE IS GOD

Young Reader's Bible: The Lord, He is God

Supplies: Printout, orange, yellow, and red tissue paper.

Open: Greet each child by name and play for three-five minutes, go over the classroom rules.

Main Point to Drive Home: God showed himself to be the One True God.

Story Time:

Take the bigger kids into the story room (leaving the door open and using the gate). Have them choose a carpet square to sit on for the story.

Review: Review the 10 Commandments up to what the kids know, add another if they're ready. Ask what they remember from the story last week. (They learned about God feeding Elijah by ravens). Explain: Elijah was a powerful messenger of God. He told kings and people messages from God and sometimes this made people very angry. Today in our story, we're going to see an amazing miracle that God did through Elijah.

Read "The Lord, He is God"

Explain: Elijah faithfully stood up for God and God miraculously showed His power through him.

Do a Craft:

Glue red, orange, and yellow tissue paper onto the picture of an altar to remember that Elijah prayed to God to show himself as the True God, and God consumed the sacrifice with fire.
