Young Reader's Bible: A Plan and a Party

Supplies: Paper crowns (purchased or made from construction paper) and sticker jewels.

Open: Greet each child by name and play for three-five minutes, go over the classroom rules.

Main Point to Drive Home: God used Esther as queen to bravely save the Jewish people.

Story Time:

Take the bigger kids into the story room (leaving the door open and using the gate). Have them choose a carpet square to sit on for the story.

Review: Review the 10 Commandments up to what the kids know, add another if they're ready. Ask what they remember from the story last week (they learned about Daniel in the Lion's Den). Explain: Today we are going to learn about time God used a queen to rescue his people.

Read "A Plan and a Party."

Explain: God placed Esther in just the right place to save his people.

Do a Craft:

Create and decorate crowns to remember how God used Queen Esther to save his people.
